

Urging the establishment of Kailasa's Hindu Library around the world for the revival of Sanatana Hindu Dharma.

By the authority vested in me as The Supreme Pontiff of Hinduism and the Head of State of Kailasa, The Living Representative of Paramashiva, by the Constitution and the laws of Sanatana Hindu Dharma as ordained by Paramashiva in vedas and agamas, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1. Purpose. Last two thousand years, due to ongoing persecution, terrorist attacks and the strategic distortment of the core pillars of Hinduism resulted in the loss of all territories, all the fifty-six nations, two hundred states, and thousand seven hundred provinces of Hinduism. The last Hindu nation, Nepal was lost in 2007. Because Hinduism lost its political legitimacy, all the scriptures have started getting destroyed and eliminated therefore there is not a single place where the original scriptures of Sanatana Hindu Dharma could be stored. The Hindu libraries such as Nalanda and Matalapu Library in Sri Lanka were burning for myriad days when it was lit by anti-Hindu forces resulting in the loss of literary legitimacy. Two hundred years before, Hinduism had ten crore, hundred millions sourcebooks, currently, Hinduism holds 20 million scriptures out of 100 million ancient scriptures. My administration and Kailasa is prioritising the urgent need for establishing Kailasa's Nithyananda Library.

KAILASA's Nithyananda Hindu Library is the world's largest knowledge center of source scriptures, manuscripts and books on Hinduism; dedicated to collecting, preserving and freely sharing 20 million Hindu texts. As foundation for the only Hindu Nation, it brings spiritual, cultural, economic legitimacy to the enlightened sciences, rituals and lifestyle.

Sec. 2. Policy. The heart-rending downfall of the prosperous Vedic civilization started in the last 1000 years when the fanatic invaders leading crusades and invasions, invaded the Vedic civilization and destroyed the knowledge. It is the policy of the Federal Government of Kailasa to usher the urgency of this establishment of KAILASA's Nithyananda Hindu Libraries to restore the existing scriptures for the revival of Sanatana Hindu Dharma.

I am therefore issuing a global call to action for all Hindus to:

- a. Engage the resources of Federal Government of Kailasa to establish Nithyananda Hindu Library and facilitate this project in coordination with the

Department of Education, all seventeen nations of KAILASA - all Samrajyams (kingdoms), Samasthanas (spiritual kingdoms), all their branches, all the 1,500 de facto embassies of KAILASA

including by:

- Building a modern-day library—restoring and bringing back the many lost and dying sciences of Sanatana Dharma to their original glory.
 - Collecting all the books pertaining to Hinduism.
 - Digitising all the Hindu scriptures and make available the knowledge to all the Hindus around the world.

- b. Encourage other ashrams, adheenams to build large Hindu Libraries to spread the knowledge of Hinduism to the whole world
 - c. Collect every book concomitant to Hinduism regardless of the language.
 - d. Every temple should collect books in accordance with the number of deities residing in the temple, the ratio being 1:1000, 1 deity equals to a collection of 1000 books allied to Hinduism.
 - e. Everything available on Hinduism in the form of books should be collected and organised legally and made available to the whole world.

Sec. 4. Responsibilities of the Kailasa's Department of Education Working Group.

Within 24 hours of the date of this order, the Working Group shall develop and submit to the Supreme Pontiff a report that outlines a plan for service coordination between all relevant stakeholders and executive departments and agencies (agencies) to provide Hindus with the access to all books pertaining to Hinduism in the form of books and digitalized copies.

Sec. 5. General Provisions. a. Nothing in this order shall be construed to impair or otherwise affect:

- i. the authority granted by law to an executive department or agency, or the head thereof; or
 - ii. the functions of the Director of the Office of Management and Budget relating to budgetary, administrative, or legislative proposals.
- b. This order shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations.
 - c. This order is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against Kailasa, its departments, agencies, or entities, its officers, volunteers, or any other person, or against any nation's integrity or laws.
