

Empowering Hindus with Ancient Vedic Solutions to experience Bliss to eradicate Mental Health conditions

Section 1. Establishment and Membership. Hereby Kailasa is establishing the Mahat Ananda Commission. The Commission's membership shall be composed of not more than twelve members, appointed by the Supreme Pontiff, including members of the Sovereign Order of Kailasa, representatives from the ShriKailasa Uniting Nations for Mental Health and Development and Department of Health. The Supreme Pontiff shall designate a Chair from among the twelve members of the Commission appointed by the Supreme Pontiff.

Sec. 2. Mission. Through innovative policies, The Federal Government of Kailasa is confronting the public challenge of Mental Health head-on. The Federal Government of Kailasa increased efforts to reduce the prevalence of Mental Conditions through various Spiritual programs such as but not limited to Mahat Ananda as mentioned in the "Vijñāna Bhairava Tantra, sutra 72, dhāraṇa 49",

In carrying out its mission, the Commission shall:

- Develop empowering sessions to educate Hindus on the science of Mahat Ananda
- Outline a plan to offer meditation techniques suited to a wider range of people to enable them to integrate Hindu spirituality into their lifestyle.
- Increase the availability of educational measures on the importance of Mahat Ananda in promoting the subjective wellbeing and bliss of an individual.
- Identify innovative digital services and technologies to spread the science of Mahat Ananda.

Sec. 3. Principles. In conducting its mission, the Commission shall adhere to the principles below:

- a) The Commission shall focus on enabling Hindus to learn techniques for an instant shift in their perceptions, their ideas about themselves and life and have a breakthrough in their consciousness.
- b) The Commission shall focus on providing powerful cognitions, and meditation techniques from Vedagamic Scriptures for all Hindus to experience bliss.

Sec. 4. Commission Decision-making. The Commission shall endeavour to make any decision on an action or determination under the direction of Veda-Agama principle, with integrity, which shall be deemed to exist where no Commission member objects to the proposed action or determination. The Commission shall work directly under the supervision of The Supreme Pontiff of Kailasa.

Sec. 5. General Provisions. a. Nothing in this order shall be construed to impair or otherwise affect:

- i. the authority granted by law to an executive department or agency, or the head thereof; or
 - ii. the functions of the Director of the Office of Management and Budget relating to budgetary, administrative, or legislative proposals.
- b. This order shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations.
- c. This order is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against KAILASA, its departments, agencies, or entities, its officers, volunteers, or any other person, or against any nation's integrity or laws.
