

Reinstating the Inner awakening in every Hindu to experience their Highest potential

Section 1. Establishment and Membership. Hereby Kailasa is establishing the Pratyakatma Chaitanya Jagrat Commission. The Commission's membership shall be composed of not more than ten members, appointed by the Supreme Pontiff, including members of the Sovereign Order of Kailasa, representatives from the ShriKailasa Uniting Nations for Mental Health and Development and Department of Health. The Supreme Pontiff shall designate a Chair from among the ten members of the Commission appointed by the Supreme Pontiff.

Sec. 2. Mission. It is the policy and mission of the federal government of Kailasa is to prioritise the ongoing mental health deteriorating along with the loss of self esteem and confidence. This has actively affected all Hindus in every field of life. Mental illnesses can impair mental health in many ways, through a wide range of conditions that affect mood, thinking, and behavior. While we have made great strides in addressing mental illnesses, millions of Hindus grapple with multiple forms associated with it. We reaffirm our continued efforts to discover better solutions for the more than 2 Billion Hindus with mental health today. Through the science of Pratyaktma chaitanya jagrat. This science amplifies the process of going beyond one's estimated potential. This science awakens the possibility, intelligence, energy and consciousness in all Hindus, solving any mental issues and replacing it with Confidence and self esteem.

In carrying out its mission, the Commission shall:

- a) Develop empowering sessions to educate Hindus on the science of Praryakatma Chaitanya jagrat.
- b) Outline a plan to offer meditation techniques suited to a wider range of people to enable the flowering of meditation within each individual.
- c) Continue to find innovative ways to link acharya expertise in this science, courses on this science, organize and facilitate digital sessions to people who need help.
- d) Increase the availability of educational measures on the importance of Pratyakatma Chaitanya Jagrat in promulgating this knowledge of reaching the highest potential and awakening power, energy and consciousness as described in the Vijnana Bhairava Tantra, Sutra 154", which belongs to the "Shaivagama" branch of the Hindu Scriptural tree.

- e) Heads of agencies shall cooperate in and facilitate production of reports based on Program information with contents and formats that permit dissemination of the program information in all digital platforms to reach out to the vast web of Hindus around the world.
- f) In strict compliance with the - all knowledge is free - clause of - Paramashiva economic policy - laid down in the Veda Agamas, all Nithya Dhyana Spurana services will be absolutely free of charge. The citizens and beneficiaries would be free to offer any amount in donation or none based on their free will.

Sec. 4. Commission Decision-making. The Commission shall endeavour to make any decision on an action or determination under the direction of Veda-Agama principle, specifically Kirana Agama, Yoga Pada with integrity, which shall be deemed to exist where no Committee member objects to the proposed action or determination. The committee shall work directly under the supervision of The Supreme Pontiff of Kailasa.

Sec. 5. General Provisions. a. Nothing in this order shall be construed to impair or otherwise affect:

- i. the authority granted by law to an executive department or agency, or the head thereof; or
 - ii. the functions of the Director of the Office of Management and Budget relating to budgetary, administrative, or legislative proposals.
- b. This order shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations.
- c. This order is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against KAILASA, its departments, agencies, or entities, its officers, volunteers, or any other person, or against any nation's integrity or laws.
