

Providing Hindus Solutions for Humanity to Combat Mental Health through Global Initiative - Nithyanandam

By the authority vested in me as The Supreme Pontiff of Hinduism and the Head of State of Kailasa, The Living Representative of Paramashiva, by the Constitution and the laws of Sanatana Hindu Dharma as ordained by Paramashiva in Vedas and agamas, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1. Policy. During these rough times, where there is a surge in poor mental and bodily health conditions of people of all ages, the Federal Government of Kailasa aims to provide the formula for inner world success which is being grounded and operating from high levels of unperturbed peace and the formula for outer world success through spiritual awakening programs such as Nithyanandam. This program presents the key to the ultimate way of existing in life - radiating the state, space, powers, being and superconsciousness of Paramshiva inside each Hindu and ultimately radiating Ishvaratva (ultimate leadership).

The ancient Vedic techniques are time-tested, most authentic and specially designed to awaken the inner potential energy as described in Vijñāna Bhairava Tantra, dharana 103, verse 128

नित्ये निराश्रये शुन्ये व्यापके कलनोज्झिते | बाह्याकाशे मनः कृत्वा निराकाशं समविशेत् || १२८ |

nitye nirāśraye śunye vyāpake kalanojjhite | bāhyākāśe manaḥ kṛtvā
nirākāśaṃ samaviśet || 128 |

One should fix his mind on the external space, bāhya-ākāśa, which is eternal, without support, void, all-pervading, devoid of limitation. By this practice, he will be absorbed beyond the etheric space, nirākāśa.

The Federal Government of Kailasa's Mission is to avail the highest attainable standard of mental and emotional well-being in all Hindus by liberating them from the clutches of the mind and emotions.

In carrying out its mission, the Commission shall:

(a) The Department of Health in coordination with ShriKailasa Uniting Nation for Mental Health and Development shall organise spiritual counselling workshops to enrich and educate the 2 Billion Hindus around the world about the importance of

meditation and spirituals practises for the wellbeing of the Hindu with ShriKailasa Uniting Nations for Consciousness Studies and Practise.

(b) The Department of Education shall develop a manual for all inspired acharyas (teachers) to equip them with the right tools required to conduct the Arogya Spurana program for a wide range of interested participants

(c) The Department of Information and Broadcasting shall enrich and empower the 2 billion Hindus and all of humanity to participate in the Arogya Spurana program by promoting the benefits of the program

(d) Outline a plan to offer meditation techniques suited to a wider range of people to enable the flowering of meditation within each individual.

Section 2. Establishment and Membership. There is hereby established the Nithyanandam Commission. The Commission's membership shall be composed of not more than ten members, appointed by the Supreme Pontiff, including members of the Sovereign Order of Kailasa, representatives from the ShriKailasa Uniting Nations for Mental Health and Development and Department of Health. The Supreme Pontiff shall designate a Chair from among the ten members of the Commission appointed by the Supreme Pontiff.

Sec. 4. Commission Decision-making. The Commission shall endeavour to make any decision on an action or determination under the direction of Veda-Agama principle, specifically Vijñāna Bhairava Tantra with integrity, which shall be deemed to exist where no Committee member objects to the proposed action or determination. The committee shall work directly under the supervision of The Supreme Pontiff of Kailasa.

Sec. 5. General Provisions. a. Nothing in this order shall be construed to impair or otherwise affect:

- i. the authority granted by law to an executive department or agency, or the head thereof; or
 - ii. the functions of the Director of the Office of Management and Budget relating to budgetary, administrative, or legislative proposals.
- b. This order shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations.
- c. This order is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against KAILASA, its

departments, agencies, or entities, its officers, volunteers, or any other person, or against any nation's integrity or laws.
