

Science of Bhakti spurna: achieving the equanimity state of mind

Section 1. Establishment and Membership. Hereby Kailasa is establishing the science of Bhakti spurna Commission. The Commission's membership shall be composed of not more than ten members, appointed by the Supreme Pontiff, including members of the Sovereign Order of Kailasa, representatives from the ShriKailasa Uniting Nations for Mental Health and Development and Department of Health. The Supreme Pontiff shall designate a Chair from among the ten members of the Commission appointed by the Supreme Pontiff.

Sec. 2. Mission. It is the policy and mission of the federal government of Kailasa is to prioritise the ongoing mental health deteriorating along with the loss of self esteem and confidence. This has actively affected all Hindus in every field of life. . While we have made great strides in addressing mental illnesses, millions of Hindus grapple with multiple forms associated with it. It is the responsibility of the federal government of kailasa to liberate all hindus from the clutches of their mind and base emotions such as: lust, greed , fear, anger envy, through the science of Bhakti spurna where one explores the inner-most layer, being unclutched with a mind of equanimity. This space enables one to experience the purest intimacy with the divine.

In carrying out its mission, the Commission shall:

- a) Develop empowering sessions to educate Hindus on the science of Bhakti spurna
- b) Outline a plan to offer meditation techniques suited to a wider range of people to enable the flowering of an unclutched mind within each individual.
- c) Continue to find innovative ways to link acharya expertise in this science, courses on this science, organize and facilitate digital sessions to people who need help.
- d) Increase the availability of educational measures on the importance of Bhakti spurna in promulgating this knowledge of bringing equanimity and deep fulfillment in one's mind, as described in Narada Bhakti Sutra 1, 2, which belongs to the "Puranana".

therefore, I will try to explain the process of devotional service:Devotional service manifests as the most elevated, pure love for God.

- e) Heads of agencies shall cooperate in and facilitate production of reports based on Program information with contents and formats that permit dissemination of the program information in all digital platforms to reach out to the vast web of Hindus around the world.
- f) In strict compliance with the - all knowledge is free - clause of - Paramashiva economic policy - laid down in the Veda Agamas, all Bhakti spurna services will be absolutely free of charge. The citizens and beneficiaries would be free to offer any amount in donation or none based on their free will.

Sec. 4. Commission Decision-making. The Commission shall endeavour to make any decision on an action or determination under the direction of Veda-Agama principle, specifically Narada Bhakti Sutra with integrity, which shall be deemed to exist where no Committee member objects to the proposed action or determination. The committee shall work directly under the supervision of The Supreme Pontiff of Kailasa.

Sec. 5. General Provisions. a. Nothing in this order shall be construed to impair or otherwise affect:

- i. the authority granted by law to an executive department or agency, or the head thereof; or
 - ii. the functions of the Director of the Office of Management and Budget relating to budgetary, administrative, or legislative proposals.
- b. This order shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations.
- c. This order is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against KAILASA, its departments, agencies, or entities, its officers, volunteers, or any other person, or against any nation's integrity or laws.
