

Setting up of Federal Register office to record, publish, and Spread the Presidential Daily Address of Supreme Pontiff of Hinduism

By the authority vested in me as The Supreme Pontiff of Hinduism and the Head of **Uniting States** of Kailasa, The Living Representative of Paramashiva, by the Constitution and the laws of Sanatana Hindu Dharma as ordained by Paramashiva in vedas and agamas, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1. Purpose. Setting up of the Federal Register Office. The Federal Register office will work to document the daily presidential address of Supreme pontiff of Hinduism, record it digitally using latest technology, preserving, digitizing as and when needed in case of upgradation of technology and publish it for the benefit of government executives, the Citizens of Kailasa and entire humanity.

This office will work towards reaching the entire humanity through all digital platforms in native language of citizens.

Section 2. Membership. The KAILASA'S Federal register Office working group shall be co-chaired by the secretary of Department of Education, Department of Information broadcasting, Department of Global Communication such representatives of other executive departments, agencies, and offices as the Co-Chairs may, from time to time, designate with the concurrence of the head of the department, agency, or office concerned. All members of the Working Group shall be full-time, or permanent part-time, officers or subjects of the Federal Government of KAILASA. The committee shall work directly under the supervision of The Supreme Pontiff of Hinduism and the Head of Uniting States of Kailasa

Section 3. Implementing Measures. The Heads of the executive departments and members set forth in section 2 of this order will work under the Instruction of Head of Uniting States of Kailasa Supreme Pontiff HDH. All the Department heads and members are instructed to implement the following measures:

1. Create and maintain Nithyananda pedia to publish the federal documents of Presidential Daily Address, treaty documents, legal documents, various meetings and other proceedings involving the Supreme Pontiff of Hinduism
2. Create a committee to translate the PDA (Presidential Daily Address) following the instructions as mentioned in Kamika Agama uttar Pada, Chapter 74, verse 21.
3. Create a committee to research and implement the latest available technology to record, preserve, publish and share with the 2 billion Hindus
4. Create a committee to research the strategies on spreading the PDA through various social media and maintain statistics which should be submitted to the Supreme Pontiff of Hinduism on a regular basis.
5. Create a technical research committee to work on devising the various devices to provide customised solution to cater the need of 2 billion Hindus across the globe and empower them with the knowledge shared by Supreme Pontiff of Hinduism
6. The working group shall work together to reach and enrich billions of lives and make the Presidential Daily Address available in all languages through 25+ Social media channels and other digital platforms like WebTv, mobile app etc. and enrich 2 billion Hindus across the globe.
7. The Secretary of Department of Information Broadcasting shall report daily comprehensive statistics on number of views, engagements, impressions etc on each of social media platforms and PDA live videos.

Sec. 4. General Provisions.

- a. Nothing in this order shall be construed to impair or otherwise affect:
 - i. the authority granted by law to an executive department or agency, or the head thereof; or
 - ii. the functions of the Director of the Office of Management and Budget relating to budgetary, administrative, or legislative proposals.
- b. This order shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations.
- c. This order is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against KAILASA, its

departments, agencies, or entities, its officers, volunteers, or any other person, or against any nation's integrity or laws.
