

Shanti Dhyana Spurana : Inner & Outer Peace Guaranteed

By the authority vested in me as The Supreme Pontiff of Hinduism and the Head of State of KAILASA, The Living Representative of Paramashiva, by the Constitution and the laws of Sanatana Hindu Dharma as ordained by Paramashiva in Vedas and Agamas, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1. Establishment and Membership. Hereby Kailasa is establishing the Shanti Dhyana Spurana. The Commission's membership shall be composed of not more than ten members, appointed by the Supreme Pontiff, including members of the Sovereign Order of Kailasa, representatives from the ShriKailasa Uniting Nations for Mental Health and Development and Department of Education. The Supreme Pontiff shall designate a Chair from among the ten members of the Commission appointed by the Supreme Pontiff.

Sec. 2. Mission. The mission of the Commission shall be to consolidate efforts to promote inner and outer peace as global priority and encourage the experience of the science of Shanti Dhyana Spurana, the ancient technique from Sanatana Dharma in all Hindus..

The Brihadarnyak Upanishad, reveals,

सर्वेशां पुर्णभवतु । सर्वेशां मङ्गलंभवतु ।
ओं शान्तिः शान्तिः शान्तिः ॥

om sarvesām svastirbhavatu । sarvesām śāntirbhavatu ।
sarvesām puṇṇambhavatu । sarvesām maṅgalambhavatu ।
om śāntiḥ śāntiḥ śāntiḥ ॥

May there be happiness in all. May there be peace in all. May there be completeness in all. May there be success in all.

In carrying out its mission, the Commission shall:

- a) Develop empowering sessions to educate Hindus on the science of Shanti Dhyana Spurana.

- b) Outline a plan to offer novel meditation techniques to enable Hindus to experientially understand peace.
- c) Increase the availability of educational measures on the importance of Shanti Dhyana Spurana in promoting mental and emotional health.
- d) Identify innovative digital services and technologies to spread the science of Shanti Dhyana Spurana.
- e) In strict compliance with the - all knowledge is free - clause of - Paramashiva economic policy - laid down in the Veda Agamas, all Shanti Dhyana Spurana services will be absolutely free of charge. The citizens and beneficiaries would be free to offer any amount in donation or none based on their free will.

Sec. 3. Principles. In conducting its mission, the Commission shall adhere to the principles below:

- a) The Commission shall focus on enlightening the Hindus the truth the entire Universe is one's projection.
- b) The Commission shall focus on enabling Hindus to create peace within to be able to mirror the same as reality outside in their lives.
- c) The Commission shall encourage and support Hindus to align their inner peace through meditation.

Sec. 4. Commission Decision-making. The Commission shall endeavour to make any decision on an action or determination under the direction of Veda-Agama principle, with integrity, which shall be deemed to exist where no Commission member objects to the proposed action or determination. The Commission shall work directly under the supervision of The Supreme Pontiff of Kailasa.

Sec. 5. General Provisions. a. Nothing in this order shall be construed to impair or otherwise affect:

- i. the authority granted by law to an executive department or agency, or the head thereof; or
 - ii. the functions of the Director of the Office of Management and Budget relating to budgetary, administrative, or legislative proposals.
- b. This order shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations.
 - c. This order is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against KAILASA, its departments, agencies, or entities, its officers, volunteers, or any other person, or against any nation's integrity or laws.
