

## Providing and Promoting the Science of Living Enlightenment

By the authority vested in me as The Supreme Pontiff of Hinduism and the Head of State of KAILASA, The Living Representative of Paramashiva, by the Constitution and the laws of Sanatana Hindu Dharma as ordained by Paramashiva in Vedas and Agamas, it is hereby ordered as follows:

**Section 1. Establishment and Membership.** Hereby Kailasa is establishing the Ananda Jeevan Commission. The Commission's membership shall be composed of not more than twelve members, appointed by the Supreme Pontiff, including members of the Sovereign Order of Kailasa, representatives from the ShriKailasa Uniting Nations for Mental Health and Development and Department of Health. The Supreme Pontiff shall designate a Chair from among the twelve members of the Commission appointed by the Supreme Pontiff.

**Sec. 2 Mission.** Through innovative policies, The Federal Government of Kailasa is confronting the public challenge of Mental Health head-on. The Federal Government of Kailasa increased efforts to reduce the prevalence of Mental Conditions through various Spiritual programs. The Federal Government of Kailasa also recognizes the vital role mental health plays in the well-being of individuals We also reaffirm our commitment to facilitating research and education, dispelling stigma around mental illnesses and providing solutions as revealed by Paramashiva in the Vedagamas, Sarvajnanottara Agama, from SadaShiva to Guha (Muruga), Shivanyayasākshātkār Patalah, Verse 56-57 Chapter 2, Vidya Pada

विज्ञानमेवम् समुपास्य विद्वान् विशत्यकायम् सततम् नियुक्तह |  
सर्वत्रगमी भवतीह मुक्तः तद्धर्म धर्मो बहिरन्त सम्स्थः || ५६ ||

vijñānamevam samupāsya vidvān viśtyakāyam satatam niyuktah |  
sarvatragamī bhavatīha muktaḥ taddharma dharmī bahiranta samsthaḥ || 56 ||

*Upon such constant practice, he reaches a bodiless state and gets established constantly in that state. He reaches all directions and places simultaneously by virtue of his bodiless and pervasive nature; he becomes the Liberated Self.*

*He becomes the possessor all the exalted qualities of Lord S'iva who presents Himself simultaneously within and outside the universe replete with moveable and immoveable existents.*

In carrying out its mission, the Commission shall:

- a) Develop empowering sessions to educate Hindus on the science of Ananda Jeevan
- b) Outline a plan to offer meditation techniques suited to a wider range of people to enable them to integrate Hindu spirituality into their lifestyle.
- c) Organise spiritual counselling workshops to enrich and educate the 2 Billion Hindus around the world about the importance of Ananda Jeevan collaboration with ShriKailasa Uniting Nations for Consciousness Studies and Practise.
- d) The Department of Education shall develop a manual for all inspired acharyas (teachers) to equip them with the right tools required to conduct the Ananda Jeevan program for a wide range of interested participants
- e) The Department of Information and Broadcasting shall enrich and empower the 2 billion Hindus and all of humanity to participate in the Ananda Jeevan program by promoting the benefits of the program

**Sec. 3. Principles.** In conducting its mission, the Commission shall adhere to the principles below

- (a) The Commission shall train the participants to imbibe a Vedic mind and yogic body. It offers the following classes
  - 1) Long sessions in presence of the master,
  - 2) Powerful talks,
  - 3) Eye-opening question and answer sessions
  - 4) Specifically designed Hindu meditation techniques
  - 5) A Vedic lifestyle with hands-on exposure to Vedic culture,
  - 6) Short trips with the master, the living representative of Paramashivato powerful temples of India

**Sec. 4. Commission Decision-making.** The Commission shall endeavour to make any decision on an action or determination under the direction of the Sarvajnanottara Agama principle with integrity, which shall be deemed to exist where no Commission member objects to the proposed action or determination. The Commission shall work directly under the supervision of The Supreme Pontiff of Kailasa.

**Sec. 5. General Provisions.** a. Nothing in this order shall be construed to impair or otherwise affect:

- i. the authority granted by law to an executive department or agency, or the head thereof; or
  - ii. the functions of the Director of the Office of Management and Budget relating to budgetary, administrative, or legislative proposals.
- b. This order shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations.
- c. This order is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against KAILASA, its departments, agencies, or entities, its officers, volunteers, or any other person, or against any nation's integrity or laws.
