

The Hindu Science of Healing all problems through Cosmic Sounds

By the authority vested in me as The Supreme Pontiff of Hinduism and the Head of State of KAILASA, The Living Representative of Paramashiva, by the Constitution and the laws of Sanatana Hindu Dharma as ordained by Paramashiva in Vedas and Agamas, it is hereby ordered as follows:

Section 1. Establishment and Membership. Hereby Kailasa is establishing the Manthra Chikitsa Commission. The Commission's membership shall be composed of not more than twelve members, appointed by the Supreme Pontiff, including members of the Sovereign Order of Kailasa, representatives from the ShriKailasa Uniting Nations for Mental Health and Development and Department of Health. The Supreme Pontiff shall designate a Chair from among the twelve members of the Commission appointed by the Supreme Pontiff.

Sec. 2 Mission. Mental illnesses can impair mental health in many ways, through a wide range of conditions that affect mood, thinking, and behaviour. While we have made great strides in addressing mental illnesses, millions of Hindus grapple with multiple forms associated with it. We reaffirm our continued efforts to discover better solutions for the more than 2 Billion Hindus with mental health today from the Vedagamas as revealed by Paramashiva.

mananam sarvaveditvam trāṇam saṁ sāryanugrahaḥ |
mananatrāṇa dharmitvān mantra ityabhidhīyate ||

The term 'manana' denotes attainment of the capacity of knowing all. The term 'trana' denotes the bestowal of grace on those, enmeshed in the worldly life. Since it possesses the power of yielding manana and trana, it is called "mantra".

In carrying out its mission, the Commission shall:

- (a) Organise spiritual counselling workshops to enrich and educate the 2 Billion Hindus around the world about the importance of Mantra Chikitsa collaboration with ShriKailasa Uniting Nations for Consciousness Studies and Practise.
- (b) The Department of Education shall develop a manual for all inspired acharyas (teachers) to equip them with the right tools required to conduct the Mantra Chikitsa program for a wide range of interested participants

- (c) The Department of Information and Broadcasting shall enrich and empower the 2 billion Hindus and all of humanity to participate in the Mantra Chikitsa program by promoting the benefits of the program

Sec. 3. Principles. In conducting its mission, the Commission shall adhere to the principles below

- (a) focuses on healing mantras which activate inner healing in the participants and move them into higher planes of consciousness.

Sec. 4. Commission Decision-making. The Commission shall endeavour to make any decision on an action or determination under the direction of Veda-Agama as per the principle of Kamikagama, with integrity, which shall be deemed to exist where no Commission member objects to the proposed action or determination. The Commission shall work directly under the supervision of The Supreme Pontiff of Kailasa.

Sec. 5. General Provisions. a. Nothing in this order shall be construed to impair or otherwise affect:

- i. the authority granted by law to an executive department or agency, or the head thereof; or
 - ii. the functions of the Director of the Office of Management and Budget relating to budgetary, administrative, or legislative proposals.
- b. This order shall be implemented consistent with applicable law and subject to the availability of appropriations.
- c. This order is not intended to, and does not, create any right or benefit, substantive or procedural, enforceable at law or in equity by any party against KAILASA, its departments, agencies, or entities, its officers, volunteers, or any other person, or against any nation's integrity or laws.
